

## Randomization Envelope

**\*Envelope is Color Coded by Age Group\***

**GREEN – is for Infants born at 23 & 24 weeks**



**ORANGE – is for Infants born at 25 & 26 weeks**




- **Select** the envelope **in sequence** (starting with number 1) for the age group
- **Do NOT open** the envelope **before** the infant is born
- If the envelope is **OPENED** and **NOT USED**, then **do NOT use** it for another qualified infant
- **SAVE** all opened envelopes – **do not discard**

# Inside the Envelope is the Randomization Card

This Card tells you the treatment arm assignment the infant is to receive

The treatment arm assignment is either **NRP-PPV** or **SI Intervention**



- Each infant is assigned to the same treatment arm
